EAST ANGLIA TRANSPORT MUSEUM Classic And Vintage Weekend 2010

The East Anglia Transport Museum at Carlton Colville near Lowestoft will be holding its Classic and Vintage Weekend again this year. Full details can be found on the Event Poster or the Museum's website. As the Sunday falls on the same day as the Federation of Historic Vehicle Clubs St. George's Day "Drive it Day" we will also be holding two runs for participating vehicles. The two start points will be Norwich Cattle Market and an as yet to be confirmed point in Saxmundham, just off the Ipswich to Lowestoft A12. There will be no charge for the run and it will include A and B class roads and visit villages and towns on route. The journey will take approximately an hour and a half and not be too stressful! Full details of the route will be sent out two weeks prior to the Event with full listings etc.

All vehicles are welcome as long they are pre 1980. Newer vehicles will only be accepted if they are part of a classic vehicle or owners club. We can accommodate Model Displays and table top "Bygones" displays under cover in the Museum's Tram and Bus Depots. Free admission to the Museum for up to four people will be given on the day for those entering a vehicle and handing over the voucher on entry with the vehicle/display.

The Museum also operates its Classic Motorbus Fleet on free services to Lowestoft Town Centre and Seafront every half an hour and to Becles Bus Station every hour. These along with Tram and Trolleybus Services around the Museum site make this a Rally with a difference, that the young and old will be sure to enjoy!
